Dear friend in freedom.

You invest in the cause of freedom because you care. You want your children and grandchildren to inherit a freer country than you've lived in. You hope that common sense will prevail and that the toxic political culture will give way to clearer minds—principled ones who respect our birthright of liberty.

I don't need to tell you how things are going. You know that we're losing. For every step forward our movement takes, we're forced to take three steps back.

So what if I told you there was an opportunity to shift the balance and better leverage your investments to effect change?

It boils down to this: I don't think we'll save our country in the Capitol—even though it's critical that we engage legislatively. And I don't think we'll save our country in the courtroom—even though it's critical that we litigate for freedom.

No—if our country is to be saved, it's at the family dinner table. It's helping parents and their children experience our ideas on a daily basis empowering them with values and

concepts that can enrich their lives and engage them in the fight.

The freedom movement generally neglects families. We speak to atomized adult voters with our policy briefs, symposia, and marketing efforts. But by then it's typically too late—it's hard to change an adult's worldview. We have to start earlier.

That's where we come in—we reach and teach entire families, empowering them to learn about and help defend the ideas of freedom. While depressing news and defeats are all around us, *this* is hopeful work.

Politics is downstream of culture, sure—but culture is downstream of the family. If we want to increase freedom, we have to engage the rising generation and make our ideas meaningful and relevant to families today.

We're doing just that—and with your help, we'd love to go further, faster.

America's college campuses are the epicenter of our country's problems. We're witnessing the closing of the American mind in real time: attacks on free speech, support for Marxism, and dumbed-down academics.

+ Strike the root recruit families

The Pyramid of Impact

Our network has three layers, each building on the prior one.

And each level is designed to reach, teach, and engage families.



The purpose of education is *action!* We connect parents to civic engagement opportunities in their community and provide their teenage and young adult children with a variety of programs to get a job, launch a business, do an internship, and more.

As families enter our network via entrepreneurship, we educate them with Tuttle Twins books, cartoons, curricula, and more to deepen their understanding of the ideas of a free society.

Entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurship is a first step to freedom; those who build something want to defend it. So we attract new families by operating hundreds of entrepreneurship events around the country.



Educating **Entrepreneurs**

Each youth entrepreneur receives a book, curriculum, and more.

Building on the first layer of our Pyramid of Impact, we help our young entrepreneurs learn about the ideas of free enterprise and how to live a prosperous life.

Beyond the markets, we reinvest our sales revenue to reach new families. As a nonprofit, our goal is to reach and teach as many people as possible. So excess revenue from book sales is used to promote them to new people, creating a virtuous cycle. The more we sell, the more we can reach and teach new families!



+ School Outreach

Our materials equip educators to share the principles of freedom in diverse classroom environments. 550+ schools using our books **Economics for** eight-year-olds? I didn't think 35,000+ books donated to schools and libraries they would find it interesting, but I was wrong! This has been such a fun resource for our students."

Building on the books, we partnered with Angel Studios to produce a cartoon series to reach even more families.

+ Our Bootcamp **Accelerator**

Our bootcamp accelerator provides self-directed individuals with the tools, networks, and experiences they need to thrive as adults. We're here to break barriers and circumvent the college conveyor belt. After all, life is too short to live by unnecessary and inefficient rules.

Scale the program.

Libertas Network acquired Praxis in early 2025 and within two years plans to serve as many students as Praxis did in its entire first decade. More young people need what we have to offer!

2 Enhance the curriculum.

With Praxis now on the Libertas team we'll be exploring ways to integrate additional resources—mentorship, advanced workshops, AI, philosophy, and more—to make the program even more impactful.

3 Build an entrepreneurship program.

Praxis focuses on helping young adults secure a well-paying job without needing to spend time and money pursuing an unnecessary degree. Some want to build their own business, and we'll build out programming and support to help up and coming entrepreneurs launch—including providing back-office support and investment opportunities to get them off the ground.









Education must lead to action.

We operate a think tank to put the ideas of freedom into action through innovative, state-level policy reforms across the country with the grassroots help of families in our network.

Nail It

We use our HQ state, Utah, as a policy incubator where we develop innovative reforms in a receptive legal environment. This increases the likelihood other states will adopt our reforms once someone else has taken the first step.

- + The only think tank in State Policy Network to win its top "Victory for Freedom" award twice.
- + 24 innovative policy reforms created that were the first of their kind in the country.
- + 87% of our policy proposals are successfully enacted into law.

Then, Scale It

We then partner with think tanks, grassroots groups, and elected officials across the country to help their states enact our reforms. The families in our network become advocates who drive the adoption of these reforms in their own states.

- + Eleven states have enacted fifteen of our policy reforms.
- + Over \$300,000 in grants awarded across 20 partner organizations to support their work.
- We have developed partnerships with 150+ organizations around the country.







+ Tracking the Public's Pulse

Overton Insights is a public opinion research firm that measures and analyzes societal attitudes and ideas to help policymakers and voters understand and navigate the evolving landscape of shifting opinion.



+ The Overton Insights team is composed of some of the most accurate pollsters with a combined 15 years experience assessing public opinion using well-crafted methodology.

We draw our name from the Overton Window, a term used to described the range of policies that are politically acceptable to the mainstream population at a given time.

Insights from our polls is shared by Libertas Institute with think tank and organizational partners across the country to inform their work and empower them to effect change.



+ Libertas Action Coalition

Building a national network of families enables us to create a pipeline into the freedom movement—a feature that has long been lacking in order to build the capacity and strength of hundreds of organizations.

Talent Pipeline

We connect the teens and young adults in our network to organizations in their state for:

- Internship and employment opportunities
- Youth leadership training and networking
- Professional development resources to learn how to be an effective advocate of freedom

Engagement Pipeline

We connect parents to organizations in their state for:

- Civic engagement and ways to get their families involved
- Training on how to create change in their community



+ Case Study: 13-year-old Aiden



#1 Aiden launched his business at our markets

Aiden lives near Phoenix, AZ, and sells a variety of 3D-printed objects. His colorful and awesome products attract a lot of attention, earning him over \$800 in revenue at each market!



#2 Aiden began reading The Tuttle Twins books

Like all our entrepreneurs, Aiden received a book at his first market. Curious to learn more, he asked his mom to buy the rest—enabling him and his siblings to learn about freedom.



#3 Aiden became politically active!

When Arizona's legislature considered our "Lemonade Stand Law" (to support young entrepreneurs), Aiden testified in committee about his experience—and the bill passed!

+ Stories of Impact

Regulatory Sandboxes

Alex Carter's American dream was shut down by regulators who felt his innovative business violated the law. In response, we created the Regulatory Sandbox, allowing entrepreneurs like Alex to operate free from bureaucratic control—and now we've helped 20 other states pass similar laws.



THE IMPACT OF LIBERTAS NETWORK

+ Youth Entrepreneurs

Young Abigail's lemonade stand was shut down for lacking a city permit, despite being only four years old. In response, we persuaded Utah's legislature to pass the first "Lemonade Stand Law," freeing young entrepreneurs from permit and license requirements. Now, over a dozen states have adopted this law with our help.



Education Entrepreneurs

Ian Lindsey spent over \$150,000 battling his city trying to get permission to launch a microschool. The city wouldn't budge and lan's legal bills added up. In response, we created the country's first microschool protection law to remove legal barriers faced by education entrepreneurs like him.




